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Important Note:

Bidders must ensure that they submit / upload on EPADS all the required documents indicated in the standard bidding documents without fail. Bids received without undertakings, valid documentary evidence, supporting documents and the manner for the various requirements mentioned in the standard bidding documents or test certificates are liable to be rejected at the initial stage itself. The data sheets, valid documentary evidences for the critical components as detailed hereinafter should be submitted / uploaded on EPADS by the bidder for scrutiny.

Applicability of Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 & Punjab Procurement Regulations, 2022

This Bidding Process will be governed under Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 & Punjab Procurement Regulations, 2022 as amended from time to time and instructions of the Government of the Punjab received during the completion of the contract.

1. Invitation to Bid

1.1 PPRA Rules to be followed

Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 will be strictly followed. These may be downloaded from PPRA's website <http://ppra.punjab.gov.pk> In this document, unless otherwise mentioned to the contrary, "Rule" means a rule under the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 and Regulations means Regulations made under the Punjab Procurement Regulatory Act, 2009.

1.2 Mode of Advertisement(s)

As per PPRA Rules, this Tender is being placed online at PPRA's website as well as on **e-Pak Acquisition & Disposal System (EPADS)**.

The bidding document carrying all details can be downloaded from PGP's website <http://www.pg.punjab.gov.pk> and EPADS as well as PPRA's website www.ppra.punjab.gov.pk in the light of instructions of PPRA and can participate in bidding process through EPADS without payment of any fee.

1.3 Type of Open Competitive Bidding

As per PPRA rules the following bidding process will be followed / adopted.

- (i) In the first instance, the "technical bid / proposal" shall be opened through EPADS;
- (ii) The procuring agency shall evaluate the technical bid / proposal in the manner prescribed in advance, without reference to the price and shall reject any Bid / proposal which does not conform to the specified requirements;
- (iii) After the evaluation and approval of the technical bid / proposals, the procuring agency shall open the financial Bids / proposals of the technically accepted bids through EPADS, publicly at a time, date and venue announced and communicated to the bidders in advance, within the bid validity period;
- (iv) The lowest evaluated bidder shall be awarded the contract.

2. Bidding Details (Instructions to Bidders)

All bids must be accompanied by bid security, as per provisions of this tender document clause "bid security" of this document in favor of "**PROSECUTOR GENERAL PUNJAB**". The bids along with the security, tender forms, affidavits, all mandatory documents etc., shall be submitted / uploaded through EPADS and original bid security shall be submitted in the office of the Prosecutor General Punjab, 1st Floor Kasuri Tower, 4-Fane Road Lahore on or before 02:00 PM on [21st October, 2025]. The technical bids shall be publicly opened through EPADS on the same day at 02:30 PM on [21st October, 2025]. In case the last date of bid submission falls in / within the official holidays / weekends, the date for opening of the bids & submission of original bid security shall be the next working day.

The bidder shall submit / upload bids only which comply with the bidding document. The attention of bidders is drawn to the provisions of this tender document clause regarding "**determination of responsiveness of bid**" and "**rejection / acceptance of the tender**" for making their bids

substantially responsive to the requirements of the bidding document.

It will be imperative for each bidder(s) to familiarize itself/ themselves with the prevailing socio-economic, political, and legal situation for the execution of contract. Purchaser shall not entertain any request for clarification from the bidder regarding such aspects after submission of the bid.

It will be the responsibility of the bidder that all factors have been investigated and considered while submitting the bid and no claim whatsoever including those of financial adjustments to the contract awarded under this bid process will be entertained by the purchaser. Neither any time schedule, nor financial adjustments arising thereof shall be permitted on account of failure by the bidder.

The bidder shall be deemed to have satisfied itself fully before Bid as to the correctness and sufficiency of its Bids for the contract and price/cost quoted in the bid to cover all obligations under this bid process.

It must be clearly understood that the terms and conditions and specifications are intended to be strictly enforced. No escalation of cost except arising from increase in quantity by the bidder on the demand and approval of the purchaser will be permitted throughout the period of completion of the contract.

The bidder should be fully and completely responsible for all the deliveries and deliverables to the purchaser. The purchaser reserves the right of inspection of supplied items at any place, bidder premises or at the desired / specified place.

Bidders should note that during the period from the receipt of the bid and until further notice from the primary contact, all queries should be communicated via the primary contact and in writing only. In the case of an urgent situation where the primary contact cannot be contacted, the bidder may alternatively direct their enquiries through the secondary contact.

Bidders are also required to state, in their proposals, the name, title, contact number (landline, mobile), fax number and e-mail address of the bidder's authorized representative through whom all communications shall be directed until the process has been completed or terminated.

The purchaser will not be responsible for any costs or expenses incurred by bidders in connection with the preparation or delivery of bids.

Failure to supply required items/services within the specified time period will invoke penalty as specified in this document.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER

3. Definitions

- 3.1 In this document, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:
- 3.2 "**Authorized Representative**" means any representative appointed, from time to time, by the purchaser or the contractor / bidder.
- 3.3 "**Availability and Reliability**" means the probability that suppliers shall be operationally ready to perform its function when called upon at any time.
- 3.4 "**Bidder/Tenderer/Contractor**" means the interested Firm/Company/Supplier/Distributors/ individual / AOP that may provide or provides the Stationery Items, Printing & Publications, Computer Stationery, Electrical, Crockery, Toiletry Items and related services to any of the public/private sector organization under the contract and have registered for the relevant business thereof.
- 3.5 "**Commencement Date of the Contract**" means the date of signing of the contract between the purchaser and the contractor.
- 3.6 "**Contract**" means an agreement entered into between the purchaser and the contractor, as recorded in the contract form signed by the parties, including all schedules and attachments thereto and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- 3.7 "**Contractor / Vendor**" means the bidder whose bid has been accepted and awarded letter of acceptance for a specific item followed by the contract signed by the purchaser.
- 3.8 "**Contract Price**" means the price payable to the contractor under the contract for the full and proper performance of its contractual obligations.
- 3.9 "**Defects Liability Expiry Certificate**" means the certificate to be issued by the purchaser to the contractor, in accordance with the contract.
- 3.10 "**Day**" means calendar day.
- 3.11 "**Defects Liability Period**" means the warranty period following the taking over, during which the contractor is responsible for making good, defects and damage in goods and services provided, under the contract.
- 3.12 "**Force Majeure**" means an event beyond the control of the contractor and not involving the contractor's fault or negligence and not foreseeable. Such events may include, but are not restricted to, acts of the purchaser in its sovereign capacity, wars, revolutions, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, and freight embargoes.
- 3.13 "**Goods**" means stationery items, printing & publications, computer stationery, electrical, crockery, toiletry items and which the contractor is required to supply to the purchaser under the contract.
- 3.14 "**Person**" includes individual, association of persons, firm, company, corporation, institution and organization, etc., having legal capacity.
- 3.15 "**Prescribed**" means prescribed in the tender document.
- 3.16 "**Purchaser**" means the office of the Prosecutor General Punjab or any other person for the time being or from time to time duly appointed in writing by the Purchaser to act as Purchaser for the purposes of the contract.
- 3.17 "**Origin**" shall be considered to be the place where the goods are produced or from where the services are provided. Goods are produced when, through manufacturing, processing or assembling of components, a commercially recognized product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.
- 3.18 "**Services**" means installation, configuration, deployment, commissioning, testing, training, support, after sale service, etc. of goods and other such obligations which the contractor is required to provide to the purchaser under the contract.
- 3.19 "**Works**" means work to be done by the contractor under the contract.
- 3.20 "**Eligible**" is defined as any country or region that is allowed to do business in Pakistan by the law of Government of Pakistan

4. Headings and Titles

In this document, headings and titles shall not be construed to be part thereof or be taken into

consideration in the interpretation of the document and words importing the singular only shall also include the plural and vice versa where the context so requires.

5. Notice

- 5.1 In this document, unless otherwise specified, wherever provision is made for exchanging notice, certificate, order, consent, approval or instructions amongst the contractor and the purchaser, the same shall be:
 - 5.1.1 In writing;
 - 5.1.2 Issued within reasonable time;
 - 5.1.3 Served by sending the same by courier or registered post to their principal office in Pakistan or such other address as they shall notify for the purpose; and
 - 5.1.4 The words "notify", "certify", "order", "consent", "approve", "instruct", shall be construed accordingly.

6. Tender Scope

- 6.1 Prosecutor General Punjab (PGP), (hereinafter referred to as "the purchaser") invites / requests proposals (hereinafter referred to as "the tenders") **through EPADS** for supply of different store items "stationery, printing & publication, computer stationery, toners, crockery, electrical, lubricants, auto parts, toiletry items and uniforms etc.)".

7. Tender Eligibility/Qualification Criteria

- 7.1 Eligible bidder/tenderer is a bidder/ tenderer who:
 - 7.1.1 Has a registered individual / incorporated company / firm/ supplier/ distributors/ AOP in Pakistan with relevant business experience.
 - 7.1.2 Must be registered with Tax Authorities as per prevailing latest tax rules (Only those which are validly registered with sales tax, income tax departments, Punjab Revenue Authority and having sound financial strengths can participate);
 - 7.1.3 Has valid registration of General Sales Tax (GST), National Tax Number (NTN), Punjab Revenue Authority (PRA) & professional tax registration;
 - 7.1.4 Experienced in sales or supply business such as "stationery, printing & publication, computer stationery, crockery, electrical and toiletry items etc.)".
 - 7.1.5 Is authorized dealer/distributor/agent if required.
 - 7.1.6 Has not been blacklisted and not involved in pending litigation before Punjab Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA);
 - 7.1.7 Has the required relevant qualified personnel and enough strength to fulfill the requirement of assignment.
 - 7.1.8 Is provider of authorized Services or authorized dealer / agent of original manufacturer of Goods or provider of Services, where applicable.
 - 7.1.9 Conforms to the clause of "Responsiveness of Bid" given herein this tender document.
 - 7.1.10 Goods and Services can only be supplied / sources / routed from "origin" in "eligible" member countries.
 - a. "**Eligible**" is defined as any country or region that is allowed to do business in Pakistan by the law of Government of Pakistan.
 - b. "**Origin**" shall be considered to be the place where the goods are produced or from which the services are provided. Goods are produced when, through manufacturing, processing or substantial and major assembling of components, a commercially recognized product results that is substantially different in basic characteristics or in purpose or utility from its components.

8. Tender Cost

The tenderer shall bear all costs / expenses associated with the preparation and submission of the tender(s) and the purchaser shall in no case be responsible / liable for those costs / expenses.

9. Joint Venture

Joint venture is not eligible for this tender.

10. Examination of the Tender Document

The bidder / tenderer is expected to examine the tender document, including all instructions and terms and conditions.

11. Clarification of the Tender Document

The bidder / tenderer may require further information or clarification of the bid document, within 05 (five) calendar days of issuance of tender through EPADS. The clarification and its reply will be shared with all prospective bidders.

Bidders should note that during the period from the receipt of the bid and until further notice from the primary contact given herein this document, all queries should be communicated via the Primary Contact and in writing. In the case of an urgent situation where the primary contact cannot be contacted, the bidder may alternatively direct their enquiries through the secondary contact.

12. Amendment of the Tender Document

12.1 The purchaser may, at any time prior to the deadline for submission of the tender, at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by the Bidder(s), amend this standard bidding document, on any account, for any reason. All amendment(s) shall be part of this standard bidding document and binding on the bidder(s).

12.2 The purchaser shall notify the amendment(s) in writing to the prospective bidders / tenderers as per Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.

12.3 The purchaser may, at its exclusive discretion, amend the tender document to extend the deadline for the submission of the tender as per Rule-25(4) of Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014.

12-A No amendment will be permissible in the bid by the bidder / tenderer after its submission.

13. Preparation / Submission of Tender

13.1 The bidder shall provide bids for **each item** mentioned in **each lot** separately. The bidder may participate in one or more or all lots but he has to provide all items mentioned in desired lot.

13.2 The tender and all documents relating to the tender, exchanged between the tenderer and the purchaser, shall be in English or Urdu. Any printed literature furnished by the tenderer in another language shall be accompanied by an English translation which shall govern for purposes of interpretation of the tender.

13.3 The tender shall be filed in / accompanied by the prescribed forms, annexes, schedules, charts, drawings, documents, brochures, literature, etc. which shall be typed, completely filled in, stamped and signed by the tenderer or his authorized representative. In case of copies, signed and stamped photocopies may be submitted.

13.4 The tender shall be in two parts i.e. the technical bid / proposal and the financial bid / proposal.

13.5 Technical proposal shall comprise the following, **without quoting the price**. Quoting of price in technical bid shall be rejected.

13.6 Technical Proposal includes

13.6.1 All bid documents duly signed and stamped by bidder.

13.6.2 Undertaking that the quoted goods are genuine, brand new, non- refurbished, unaltered in any way.

13.6.3 Technical brochures / literature if any

13.6.4 Details of warranty and After-Sale Service at office of Prosecutor General Punjab, Lahore.

13.6.5 Submission of undertaking that the firm is not blacklisted and not involved in pending litigation before Punjab Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) or at any other competent forum.

13.6.6 The contractor's financial capacity to mobilize and sustain the supply of goods is imperative. In the proposal, the bidder is required to provide information about its financial status. This requirement can be met with by submission of income tax return for the last one (01) year.

13.6.7 Bid Security, as per provisions of the clause "bid security" of this document

13.7 The Financial Proposal shall comprise the following:

13.7.1 Financial proposal includes

13.8 The tenderer shall prepare the financial bid / proposal in single file duly marked as under:

13.9 The bids / proposals shall be submitted / uploaded through EPADS and original instrument of bid security will be provided to the Purchaser's office, during office hours, up to due date and time.

14. Tender Price

14.1 The quoted price shall be for all items mentioned in each desired lot and also shall be:

14.1.1 Best / final / fixed and valid until completion of all obligations under the contract i.e. not subject to variation / escalation;

14.1.2 In Pak Rupees;

14.1.3 Inclusive of all taxes, duties, levies, insurance, freight, etc. except 18% GST if applicable; 18% GST will be mentioned in separate column as per format given in price schedule.

14.1.4 Including all charges up to the delivery point as provided by procuring Agency.

14.2 If not specifically mentioned in the Tender(s), it shall be presumed that the quoted price is as per the above requirements.

14.3 In case of locally produced equipment/service, the price shall include all customs duties and sales and other taxes already paid or payable on the components and raw materials used in the manufacture or assembly of the item.

15. Bid Security

15.1 The tenderer shall furnish the bid security as under:

15.1.1 For a sum equivalent to **05%** of the total tender **estimated price** (as mentioned against each category in tender documents) in the form of **Bank Guarantee / CDR / Bankers Cheque etc**, issued by a scheduled bank operating in Pakistan, in the name of the purchaser,;

15.1.2 Denominated in Pak rupees;

15.1.3 **Scanned copy must be uploaded on EPADS and original instrument must be delivered in purchaser office till closing date and time**, failing which will cause rejection of bid.

15.1.4 Have a minimum validity period of ninety **(90) days** from the last date for submission of the tender or until furnishing of the performance security, whichever is later.

15.2 The **bid security** shall be forfeited by the purchaser, on the occurrence of any / all of the following conditions:

15.2.1 If the tenderer withdraws the tender during the period of the tender validity specified by the tenderer on the tender form; or

15.2.2 If the tenderer does not accept the corrections of his total tender price; or

15.2.3 If the tenderer, having been notified of the acceptance of the tender by the purchaser during the period of the tender validity, fails or refuses to furnish the performance security, in accordance with the tender document.

15.3 The bid security shall be returned to the technically unsuccessful tenderer with unopened/sealed financial bid while the unsuccessful bidders of financial bid opening procedure will be returned the bid security only. The bid security shall be returned to the successful tenderer upon furnishing of the performance security.

16. Tender Validity

The tender shall have a minimum validity period till **30.06.2026**. The purchaser may solicit the tenderer's consent to an extension of the validity period of the tender. The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing. If the tenderer agrees to extension of validity period of the tender, the validity period of the bid security shall also be suitably extended. The tenderer may refuse extension of validity period of the tender, without forfeiting the bid security.

17. Opening of the Tender

- 17.1 Tenders (technical bids & financial bids) shall be opened at 02:30 PM. on the last date of submission of bids i.e. [21st October, 2025] through EPADS, in the presence of the tenderer(s) / representative for which they may ensure their presence without further invitation. In case the last date of bid submission falls in / within the official holidays / weekends of the Purchaser, the last date for submission of original instrument of bid security & opening of the bids shall be the next working day.
- 17.2 The tenderer's name, modifications, withdrawal, security, attendance of the tenderer and such other details as the purchaser may, at its exclusive discretion, consider appropriate, shall be announced and recorded.
- 17.3 No tenderer or its representative will be allowed to record tender opening proceedings through any digital device (camera, audio recorder, cell phone etc.) during tender opening meeting at given time and location. Non-compliance will cause the rejection of respective bidder.

18. Clarification of the Tender

The purchaser shall have the right, at his exclusive discretion, to require, in writing, further information or clarification of the Tender, from any or all the tenderer(s). No change in the price or substance of the tender shall be sought, offered or permitted except as required to confirm the corrections of arithmetical errors discovered in the tender. Acceptance of any such correction is sole discretion of the purchaser.

19. Determination of Responsiveness of the Bid (Tender)

- 19.1 The purchaser shall determine the substantial responsiveness of the tender to the tender document, prior to the tender evaluation, on the basis of the contents of the tender itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence. A substantially responsive tender is one which:
- 19.1.1 Meets the eligibility criteria given herein this tender document/ the goods ;
- 19.1.2 Meets the technical specifications for the goods against each item;
- 19.1.3 Meets the delivery period / point for the goods against each item;
- 19.1.4 Is in compliance with the rate and limit of liquidated damages;
- 19.1.5 Offers fixed price quotations for the Goods against each item;
- 19.1.6 Is accompanied by the required bid security as part of financial bid envelope.
- 19.1.7 Is in compliance with the preparation/submission of tender in a manner prescribed in this tender document clause-13;
- 19.1.8 Conforms to all terms and conditions of the tender document, without material deviation or reservation. A material deviation or reservation is one which affects the scope, quality or performance of the goods or limits the purchaser's rights or the tenderer's obligations under the contract.
- 19.2 The tender determined as not substantially responsive shall not subsequently be made responsive by the Tenderer by correction or withdrawal of the material deviation or reservation. However, the purchaser may waive off any minor non-conformity or inconsistency or informality or irregularity in the tender.

20. Correction of errors / Amendment of Tender

- 20.1 The tender shall be checked for any arithmetic errors which shall be rectified, as follows:
- 20.1.1 If there is a discrepancy between the amount in figures and the amount in words for the total tender price entered in the tender form, the amount which tallies with the total tender price

entered in the price schedule, shall govern.

- 20.1.2 If there is a discrepancy between the unit rate and the total price entered in the price Schedule, resulting from incorrect multiplication of the unit rate by the quantity, the unit rate as quoted shall govern and the total price shall be corrected, unless there is an obvious and gross misplacement of the decimal point in the unit rate, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit rate shall be corrected.
- 20.1.3 If there is a discrepancy in the actual sum of the itemized total prices and the total tender price quoted in the price schedule, the actual sum of the itemized total prices shall govern.
- 20.2 The tender price as determined after arithmetic corrections shall be termed as the corrected total tender price which shall be binding upon the tenderer.
- 20.3 Adjustment shall be based on corrected tender prices. The price determined after making such adjustments shall be termed as evaluated total tender price.
- 20.4 No credit shall be given for offering delivery period earlier than the specified period.

21. MANDATORY / TECHNICAL EVALUATION CRITERIA

The technical proposals shall be evaluated by the Tender Evaluation (Procurement) Committee in the light of following evaluation criteria:-

22. FINANCIAL PROPOSAL EVALUATION

- 22.1 Financial Bids of technically qualified/successful bidder(s)/tenderer(s) shall be opened through EPADS on date and time which will be communicated to bidders later on. The financial proposals will be opened in the presence of the bidders.
- 22.2 Financial proposal evaluation will be conducted under the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 and Punjab Procurement Regulations, 2022. The price evaluation will include all duties, taxes and expenses etc except 18% GST. In case of any exemption of duties and taxes made by the

government in favor of the purchaser, the contractor shall be bound to adjust the same in the financial proposal.

- 22.2.1 In cases of discrepancy between the cost/price quoted in words and in figures, the lower of the two will be considered.
 - 22.2.2 In evaluation of the price of an imported item, the price will be determined and considered inclusive of the customs and other import duties etc.;
 - 22.2.3 In evaluation of the price of articles/goods which are subject to excise duty, sales tax, income tax or any other tax or duty levied by the government, the price will be determined and considered inclusive of such duties and taxes except 18% GST and any other.
 - 22.2.4 Delivery expenditures should be included in offered rates as per delivery schedule provided by the purchaser at Lahore or any other city of the Punjab.
- 22.3 The purchaser will not be responsible for any erroneous calculation of tax rates or any subsequent changes in rates or structure of applicable taxes. All differences arising out as above shall be fully borne by the successful bidder.

23. Rejection / Acceptance of the Bid

- 23.1 The purchaser shall have the right, at his exclusive discretion, to increase / decrease the quantity of any or all item(s) without any change in unit prices or other terms and conditions. The Purchaser may cancel/reject all bids or proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid or proposal. The purchaser shall upon request communicate to any bidder, the grounds for its rejection of all bids or proposals, but shall not be required to justify those grounds. The purchaser shall incur no liability, solely, by virtue of its invoking sub-rule (1) of Rule-35 of Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014 towards the bidders. However, bidders shall be promptly informed about the rejection of the bids, if any (As per rule 35 of Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014).
- 23.2 The tender shall be rejected if it is:
- 23.2.1 Substantially non-responsive in a manner prescribed in this tender document clause-20; or
 - 23.2.2 Submitted in other than prescribed forms, annexes, schedules, charts, drawings, documents / by other than specified mode; or
 - 23.2.3 Incomplete, un-sealed, un-signed, printed (hand written), partial, conditional, alternative, late; or
 - 23.2.4 Subjected to interlineations / cuttings / corrections / erasures / overwriting; or
 - 23.2.5 The tenderer refuses to accept the corrected total tender price; or
 - 23.2.6 The tenderer has conflict of interest with the purchaser; or
 - 23.2.7 The tenderer tries to influence the tender evaluation / contract award; or
 - 23.2.8 The tenderer engages in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract award;
 - 23.2.9 The tenderer fails to meet all the requirements of tender eligibility / qualification criteria (Clause-7);
 - 23.2.10 The tenderer fails to meet the evaluation criteria requirements (clause-21);
 - 23.2.11 The tenderer has been blacklisted by any public or private sector organization;
 - 23.2.12 The Tendered has mentioned any financial implication(s) in the financial proposal that is in contradiction to this document and government rules and regulations.
 - 23.2.13 There is any discrepancy between bidding documents and bidder's proposal i.e. any non-conformity or inconsistency or informality or irregularity in the submitted

bid.

23.2.14 The tenderer submits any financial conditions as part of its bid which are not in conformity with tender document.

24. Award Criteria

24.1 At first step, eligible bidder(s)/tenderer(s) as per clause-7 of tender eligibility of this tender document fulfilling the qualification and technical evaluation criteria against each lot will stand technically qualified.

24.2 At second step, technically qualified and successful bidder(s)/tenderer(s) will be evaluated in the light of all pre-conditions, necessary requisites and shall be selected on lowest cost quoted as per rules and fulfilling all codal formalities against each lot.

25. Acceptance Letter

As per provisions of rule (55) of Punjab Procurement Rules 2014, the purchaser shall issue the acceptance letter to the successful tenderer, at least after 10 days of announcement of bid evaluation reports and prior to the expiry of the original validity period or extended validity period of the tender, which shall constitute a contract, until execution of the formal contract against each item.

26. Performance Guarantee / Security

26.1 The successful bidder shall furnish performance guarantee / security as under:

26.1.1 within three (03) days of the receipt of the acceptance letter from the purchaser;

26.1.2 in the form of **Bank Guarantee / CDR / Bankers Cheque etc** issued by a scheduled bank operating in Pakistan;

26.1.3 For a sum Equivalent to **10%** of the contract value;

26.1.4 Denominated in Pak rupees;

26.1.5 Have a minimum validity period until the date of expiry of warranty period i.e. **01 Year** support period or termination of services, or fulfillment of all obligations under the contract, whichever is later. No performance security shall be acceptable with any validity less than the prescribed time period.

26.2 The performance security shall be payable to the purchaser, on occurrence of any / all of the following conditions:

26.2.1 If the contractor commits a default under the contract;

26.2.2 If the contractor fails to fulfill the obligations under the contract;

26.2.3 If the contractor violates any of the terms and conditions of the contract.

26.3 The contractor shall cause the validity period of the performance guarantee / security to be extended for such period(s) as the contract performance may be extended. The performance guarantee / security shall retain by the purchaser till expiry of warranty period of supplied items and be returned to the bidder within thirty working days after the expiry of its validity & warranty period on written request from the bidder.

26.4 In case the contractor fails to furnish Performance guarantee / security in shape of **Bank Guarantee / CDR / Bankers Cheque etc** within the stipulated period given under letter of acceptance and subsequent formal contract, or till end of the said contract, the amount of **Bank Guarantee / CDR / Bankers Cheque etc**, as required, shall be deducted from the amount payable to the contractor.

27. Schedule of Delivery

27.1 the delivery period shall be **15** days for general items and **20** days for printing items w.e.f the date of issuance of supply / purchase order (without penalty) in the office of Prosecutor General Punjab, kasuri tower 4 fane road Lahore. The bidder would bear transportation charges. The delivery period may be extended by the procuring agency if necessary but it shall not be more than 10 days.

27.2 However, in special cases, delivery period can be fixed shorter or higher than the above-mentioned schedule of requirement as deem appropriate by the Procuring Agency.

27.3 In case of late delivery of goods beyond the periods specified in the supply order, penalty @ 0.25% per day of the total cost of the purchase order/contract value for late delivered supply shall be imposed upon the Supplier.

27.4 In case of late delivery, the delivery period will be started from the date of receipt of purchase/ supply order by the supplier.

Award of Contract

29. Acceptance of Bid and Award criteria

29.1 The bidder with successfully technically evaluated and lowest financial bid, if not in conflict with any other law, rules & regulations, policy of the government or having less bid security shall be awarded the Contract, within the original or extended period of bid validity.

29.2 The procuring agency reserves the right at the time of contract award to increase or decrease the quantity of goods originally specified in the Price Schedule and Schedule of requirements without any change in unit price or other terms and conditions.

29.2.1 The successful bidder shall be bound to submit samples of items as per offered / decided specifications within 05 days after signing of the contract.

29.3 Notification of Award of Contract

29.3.1 Prior to the expiration of the period of bid validity, the procuring agency shall notify the successful bidder in writing by registered letter or through personal receiving by the bidder representative that its bid has been accepted.

29.3.2 The notification of award shall constitute the formation of the contract.

29.4 Signing of Contract

29.4.1 At the same time as the procuring agency notifies the successful bidder that its bid has been accepted, the procuring agency shall send the bidder the contract form provided in the bidding documents and contract will be signed on stamp paper provided by the bidder @ **0.25%** of the total value of the contract. In pursuance of rule 2(sa) & 15 of the Punjab Procurement Rules, 2014, the procuring agency may sign framework contract with successful bidder till the bid validity period i.e **30.06.2026** and also issue supply order time to time as per need, requirement & availability of budget.

30 Redressal of grievances by the procuring agency

30.1 The procuring agency shall constitute a committee comprising of odd number of persons, with proper powers and authorizations, to address the complaints of bidders that may occur prior to the entry into force of the procurement contract.

30.2 Any bidder feeling aggrieved by any act of the procuring agency after the submission of his bid may lodge a written complaint concerning his grievances within five days of announcement of technical evaluation report and ten days after issuance of final evaluation report.

30.3 The committee shall investigate the complaint and decide the complaint within fifteen days of the receipt of the complaint.

30.4 Mere fact of lodging of a complaint shall not warrant suspension of the procurement process.

30.5 Any bidder not satisfied with the decision of the grievance redressal committee constituted by procuring agency, may file a representation before Managing Director, PPRA within seven days of communication of decision.
